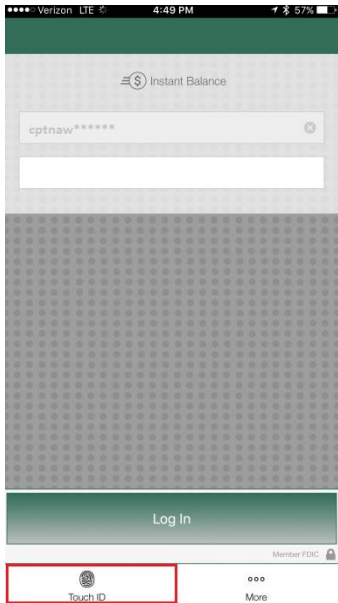
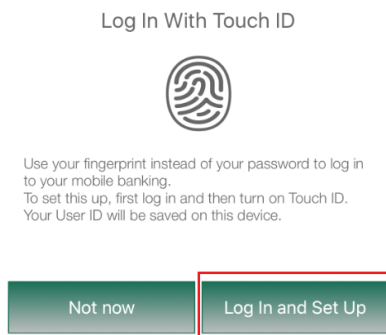


## Touch ID For iPhones Retail Mobile Banking - Activating From the Login Screen

1. When you first open the CNB Mobile App, you will notice a Touch ID button on the bottom of the screen, tap Touch ID.



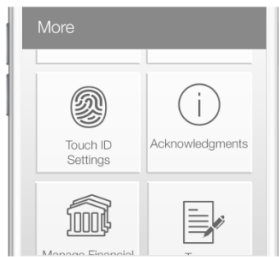
2. This will prompt the following image to come up explaining what Touch ID is. If you wish to proceed with the setup tap, Log In and Set Up. If not, choose Not now.



3. There then will be another image that explains what's new. Once you read this, tap the X in the top right corner.

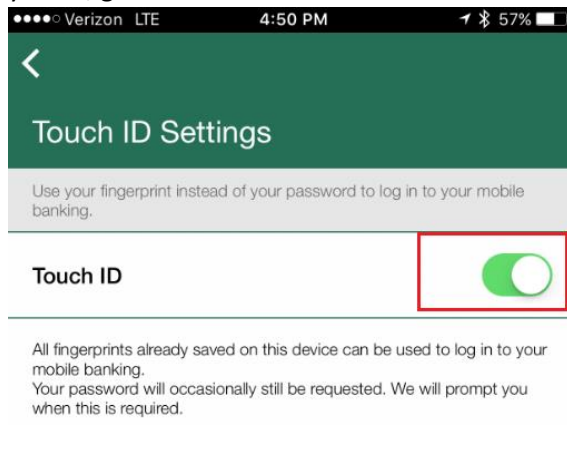
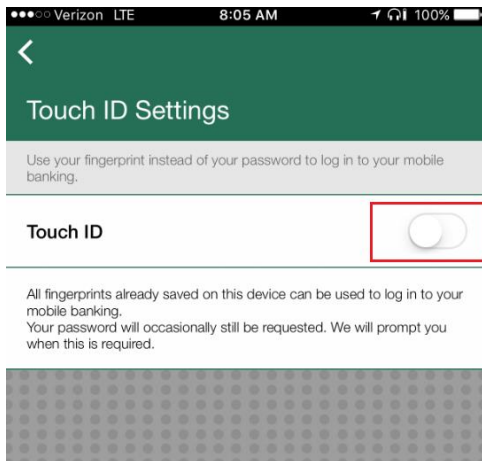


Log In With Touch ID

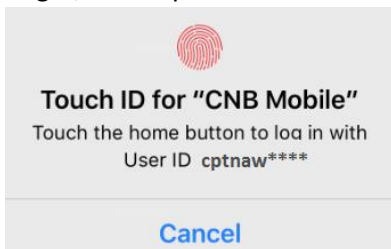


Use the saved fingerprints on your phone to log in to this app. Touch ID can be turned on, or off at any time under the More Menu.

4. This will then bring you to the settings page where you just need to tap the slider for Touch ID to turn it on. Gray is off, green is on.

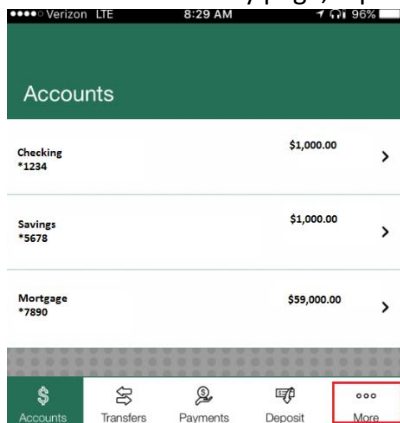


5. Going forward, on the log in screen, you will see the below image. Simply use your normal finger/thumb print to activate the Touch ID.

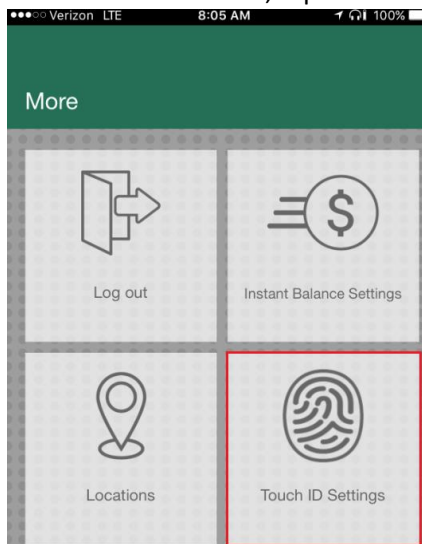


## Touch ID for iPhones Retail Mobile Banking -Activating From Within the App

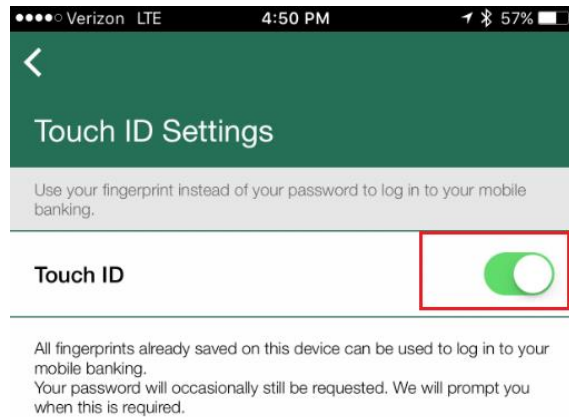
1. Log into the CNB Mobile App using your username and password.
2. At the bottom of any page, tap the More button.



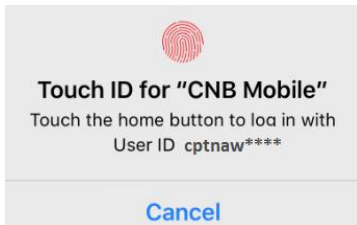
3. From the More Menu, tap the Touch ID Settings button.



- This will then bring you to the settings page where you just need to tap the slider for Touch ID to turn it on. Gray is off, green is on.



- Going forward, on the log in screen, you will see the below image. Simply use your normal finger/thumb print to activate the Touch ID.
